2023 was a year of new highs for Paradise Parrot Rescue! For years, I have dreamed of building a larger facility that is custom designed for all aspects of parrot rescue, with the birds and volunteers top of mind. With the success of the rescue and the generosity of our donors, we were able to begin the design phase of this new endeavor. We have reached about 50% of the funding we need, but with a bit of faith, we have hired a local contractor and we should break ground in 2024 on phase 1 of the new 3200 sq. ft. building. We will be working on fundraising in 2024 to gain the full amount we will need. We have not had to turn away parrots to date due to space restrictions, but we are at capacity and without a new and larger facility, we would not be able to rescue the birds who need our love and care.

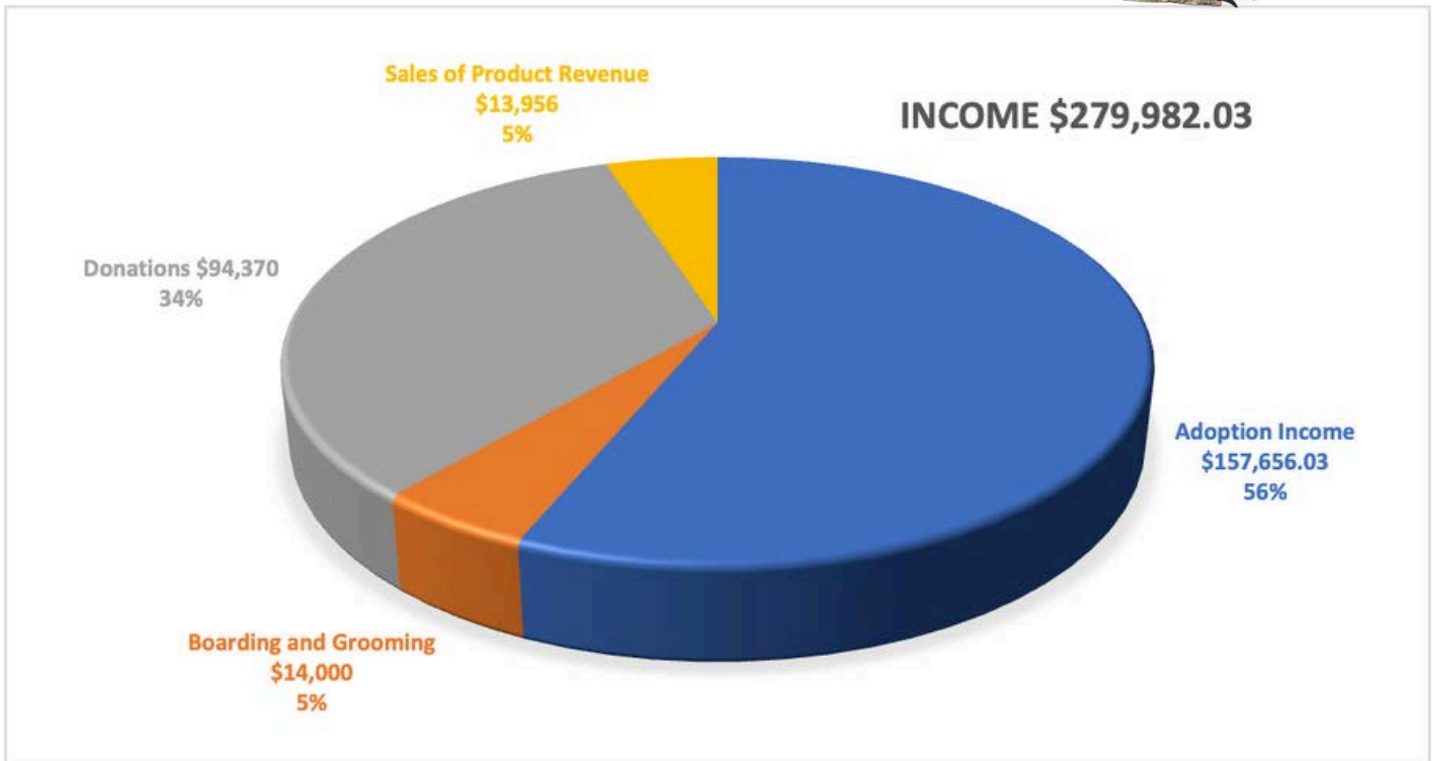

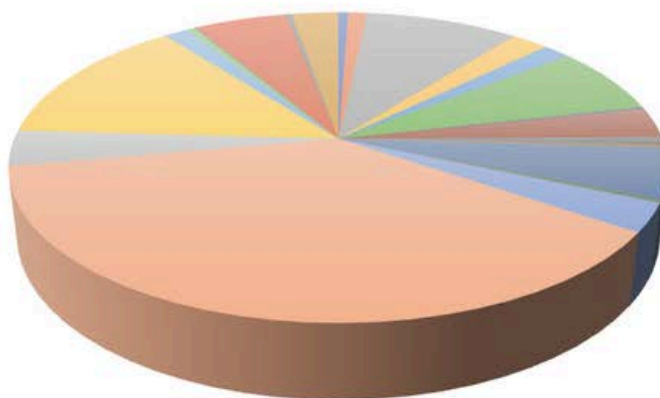
